

Cookie Policy

The Soapy Reels website may use "cookies" to help you personalize your online experience. Cookies are small data files stored on your hard drive by a website. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you. We may use both session cookies (which expire when you close your web browser) and persistent cookies (which stay on your computer until you delete them) to provide you with a more personal and interactive experience on our Site.

Why We Use Cookies

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalize Soapy Reels pages or register with Soapy Reels site or services, a cookie helps Soapy Reels to recall your specific information on subsequent visits. This simplifies the process of recording your personal information, such as billing addresses, shipping addresses, and so on. When you return to the same Soapy Reels website, the information you previously provided can be retrieved, so you can easily use the Soapy Reels features that you customized.

You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. Most Web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. If you choose to decline cookies, you may not be able to fully experience the interactive features of the Soapy Reels services or websites you visit.

Types of Cookies We Use

Strictly Necessary	Required for the website to operate properly — e.g. secure login, shopping cart, purchased products, cookie consent preference.	Session
Analytical / Performance	Allow us and our third-party service providers to recognize and count visitors and see how they navigate the website. Generate aggregate statistics (pages visited, time on pages, navigation patterns). These are not associated with an individual profile.	Session
Functionality	Enable helpful but non-essential functions that improve your experience — e.g. remembering your language, region, theme, or login details. Do not enable visitor identification over time and across websites.	Session
Advertising / Targeting	Record information about your visit (pages visited, links followed, videos viewed) so we can make our website and advertising more relevant to your interests. Do not enable visitor identification over time and across websites.	Session
Third-Party	Our website may contain features or plug-ins enabling third-party services (social networks, maps, advertising networks, web traffic analysis). These cookies may enable visitor identification across websites and over time. We do not control third-party use of those cookies, their duration, or their ability to share data with other parties.	Persistent

Strictly Necessary Cookies

Our website requires the use of these cookies to properly operate or provide necessary functions relating to the services you request. These include cookies that enable you to securely log in, use a shopping cart, and purchase products. These are session cookies used for proper website functions.

Analytical / Performance Cookies

These cookies allow us and our third-party service providers to recognize and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our website when they are using it. This helps us improve how our website works by ensuring that users can easily find what they need. Uses include:

- Identifying which parts of the site are popular or underperforming.
- Fixing slow-loading pages and optimizing layout and design.
- Improving content based on user engagement.
- Measuring traffic trends over time.

Functionality Cookies

These cookies enable helpful but non-essential website functions that improve your experience. By recognizing you when you return to our website, they may allow us to personalize our content for you, greet you by name, or remember your preferences (such as your choice of language or region). Uses include:

- Storing language selection, region or location, and theme (light/dark mode).
- Displaying customized content and remembering login details (if enabled).
- Tailoring the interface based on past interactions.

Advertising, Tracking or Targeting Cookies

These cookies enable different advertising-related functions. They may allow us to record information about your visit to our website, such as pages visited, links followed, and videos viewed, so we can make our website and the advertising displayed on it more relevant to your interests. Uses include:

- Displaying ads based on your interests and activity across websites.
- Limiting repetitive ads (frequency capping).
- Providing a balanced variety of advertising content.

Third-Party Cookies

Our website may contain helpful but non-essential features or plug-ins enabling third-party services that use cookies, such as social network connectors, maps, advertising networks, or web traffic analysis services. These cookies may enable visitor identification across websites and over time. These third-party cookies are likely to be analytical, performance, or targeting cookies. We do not control the third party's use of those cookies, their duration, or their ability to share information with other third parties.
